Wilfredo "Choco" De Jesús, former senior pastor of New Life Covenant Church in Chicago, one of the largest US congregations in the Assemblies of God, served as General treasurer of the Assemblies of God and has recently been appointed as the new executive director of U.S. Missions, He is the founder of the nonprofit agency Chicago Dream Center, which serves the city of Chicago through residential, outreach, and rescue programs. 




